RINGING IN THE RENEWAL YEAR!

Beginning in January of 2019, much anticipated work will begin on the RENEW phase of our Centennial journey. All parish members received a letter from Father Dittmer recently, outlining the current status of our RENEW Fund Drive and listing the highest priority items that will be completed based on our funds.

The following maintenance items will be included: painting the walls, replacing the carpet and upgrading the sound system. Construction of the re-designed Sanctuary, an improvement item, will also be included. This work will necessitate some temporary changes to St. Anne's Mass locations starting the weekend of January 12th and 13th:

- Saturday 4:00 p.m. Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary's, Moline with confession held prior to Mass at 3:00 p.m.
- Sunday 10:00 a.m. Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of Guadalupe, Silvis.
- Weekday Masses will be celebrated at 7:30 a.m. in the Chapel at St. Anne's.
- School Masses will be celebrated at 9:30 a.m. on Thursdays in Cleary Hall.

Your understanding, patience and flexibility will be greatly appreciated during this transformational time. Your prayers for a successful and timely completion of this work are requested as we prepare to celebrate our Easter Season in an awe-inspiring, renovated parish home.

A revival of the good old-fashioned St. Anne Spaghetti Supper was hosted by the Stewardship Committee on October 20th in Cleary Hall. The original spaghetti sauce recipe (from “back in the day” – see recipe to the right) was prepared for this event. The tables were decorated with red and white checkered tablecloths with centerpieces of pretty pasta jars and flowers – making the gym feel like an authentic Italian restaurant. What does it take to feed over 250 hungry attendees? The Committee prepared the sauce using 80 pounds of ground beef, cooked 54 pounds of spaghetti, and baked over 600 breadsticks!

170 “early birds” bought tickets in advance and were entered in a drawing to win a 32-inch flat screen TV, plus 84 tickets were sold at the door. The TV was won by Rita Trulson and 6 lucky attendees bought winning “torn card” chances at the event and went home with \$50 prizes.

Adding to the celebration, sales of all the St. Anne Centennial commemorative items were kicked off at this event. Shirts, mugs, and Christmas ornaments were on display. The Centennial Quilt was also on display and quilt raffle tickets were available for sale.

Sincere thanks to the many volunteers who worked to make this popular event a success. The final profit was \$1,514.28 – as they say in Italy, **fantastico!!**

Serves 75 - 90 people

20 lbs.	Hamburger
1 Cup	Yellow Mustard
8 (12 oz)	Tomato Paste
1 (#10 can)	Tomato Sauce
8 Cups	Water
1 Cup	Sugar
6 pkg.	Dry Sauce Mix (Use French's Only)
7 ½ T.	Salt
3 Cups	Onions
1 Cup	Green Pepper (Chopped)
