INFORMATION & RULES

Our concession stand will open at 5:30 p.m. Games will start at 6:30 p.m.

(Please note: For a situation of inclement weather on a scheduled BINGO date, you can call 309-755-5071 after 4:00 p.m. In the event of cancellation, the recording will state that BINGO has been cancelled.)

A 15-minute intermission will be held after Game 7.

50/50 CHANCES will be sold for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00. The drawing will be held prior to the last game. You must be present to win. You do not have to be a BINGO player to win.

BINGO Players must be at least 18 years old.

The cost of one Regular BINGO packet is \$15.00 -- this is 14 sheets with 6 cards per sheet. <u>Every Regular BINGO player must purchase a \$15.00 packet</u>. Extra packets can be purchased for \$5.00 each.

The cost to play for the "Bonus Ball" Jackpot is \$1.00. At 6:30 p.m. sales will be closed and the "Bonus Ball" number for the evening will be determined and announced.

To win the "Bonus Ball" Jackpot, an eligible player must BINGO on one of the first 14 BINGO games of the evening and the last number called must be the "Bonus Ball" number. Verification of a winner will consist of confirming a good BINGO on the last number called, which must be the "Bonus Ball" number, and confirming eligibility by locating a signature on the "Bonus Ball" roster sheet.

If there is no winner of the "Bonus Ball" Jackpot, the prize money shall be carried over and added to the prize amount for the next BINGO evening. When the "Bonus Ball" Jackpot prize reaches \$400, the prize will remain at \$400 for subsequent BINGO evenings until a winner is determined.

Special sheets with 3 cards per sheet must be purchased for the Final BINGO game. The cost for every Final BINGO sheet is \$5.00.

Any potential winners must announce their BINGO and be acknowledged by any worker BEFORE the NUMBER on the next ball is called. (NO SLEEPERS). This means that to be declared a winner, your BINGO must contain the last NUMBER that was called.

Numbers must be verified by the official caller's table before a pay-out is given.

In the event of a tie, the dollar amount allocated for that game prize will be split evenly.
